

Schedule of Classes New Features

Expanded search criteria: In addition to searching by GE, Writing II, Fiat Lux, and CUTF, we've added searches for diversity and service learning. The search criteria are dynamic and will only display when there is a class available in the term you've selected. For example, you will only see CUTF appear in the dropdown menu for winter and spring when those classes are offered. This also means if there are no classes in a subject area for a given term, that subject area won't be in the dropdown menu. (Especially helpful if your subject area code changes mid-year!)

Writing II classes satisfy the undergraduate Writing II requirement. They can be identified by their W suffix. To enroll in a Writing II class, students must have satisfied the Writing I requirement.

In a Writing II class, students prepare three to four analytical papers. They receive extensive instructor and student input, and learn how to become better writers.

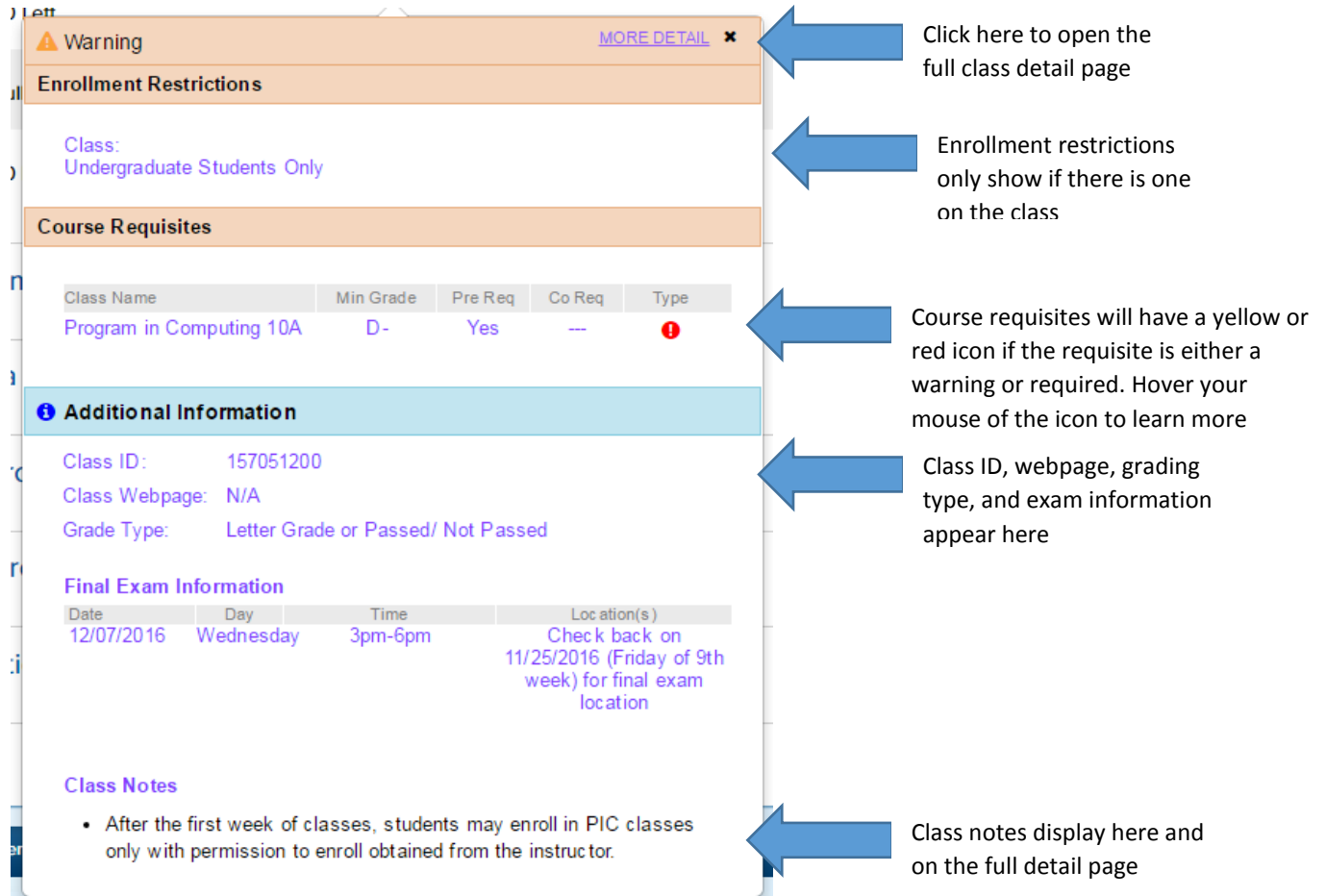

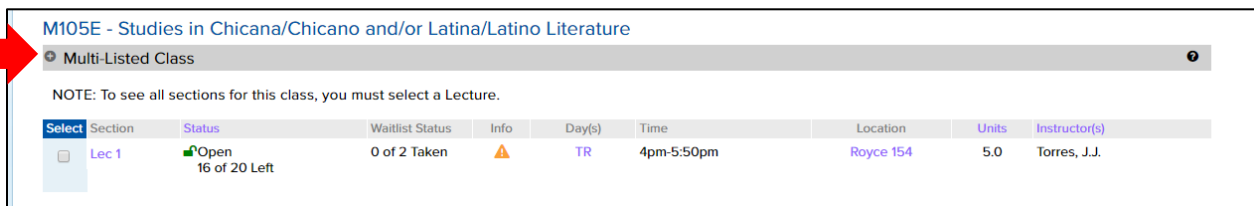
